COMMUNITY GARDEN IS IN FULL SWING: FRESH PRODUCE AVAILABLE

The Pittston Community Garden is located between the Apollo and Infantino Tower Housing Sites. The Community Garden was a partnership between the Pittston Area High School Greenhouse, Garden Goombas, and the Pittston Housing Authority. The Garden Goombas planted a variety of local fresh produce with some coming right from students at the Pittston Area Greenhouse! There are two varieties of eggplants, tomatoes, cucumbers, zucchini, green peppers, and plenty of basil. Any tenant in any development, and any Pittston City resident, is welcome to the fresh produce. When it's harvested, the produce is placed in the basket outside of the garden. Please stop in and let us know how you used your produce or what kind of creative recipes you've come up with. Stay tuned for more programming activities at the Community Garden.





RIVERVIEW MANOR DEMOLITION APPLICATION

The Housing Authority submitted the Demolition application to HUD for Riverview Manor. The next step is for HUD to review the application and respond with questions. The timeline for this transition is still expected to be 3 years, contingent on HUD approval and we will update residents when we have updates to share.

- ANNUAL PLAN AND MOVE TO WORK SUPPLEMENT :

The Housing Authority was designated as a MTW Agency and will be working over the next several months to make changes that allow for an increase in housing choice, homeownership opportunities, and tools for family-self-sufficiency.
